

English

- Key text: Egyptology by Dugald Steer
- Narrative – description piece based on an object in the classroom coming to life!
- Balanced Argument – stating before the pros and cons to a statement or question
- Formal letter – letter to Mr Simmons about something in the school they would like to change.
- Non-narrative – Links to history and topic - information text, explanations.
- GPS – Consolidation of key terminology: being able to recognise and identify, in example sentences, or to be able to use it accurately in our own sentences.



Maths

- Ratio - Using ratio language, Ratio and fractions, introducing the ratio symbol, Calculating ratio, Using scale factors, Calculating scale factors, Ratio and proportion problems .
- Algebra - Use simple formulae., Generate and describe linear number sequences, Express missing number problems algebraically.
- Geometry –name parts of circles, including radius, diameter and circumference and know that the diameter is twice the radius, Interpret and construct pie charts and line graphs and use these to solve problem(s), recognising different angle types, finding the missing angle size(s) within a polygon or turn.
- Consolidation of key arithmetic skills (involving four operations)
- Investigations and problem solving tasks

- **Invasion games** – tag rugby

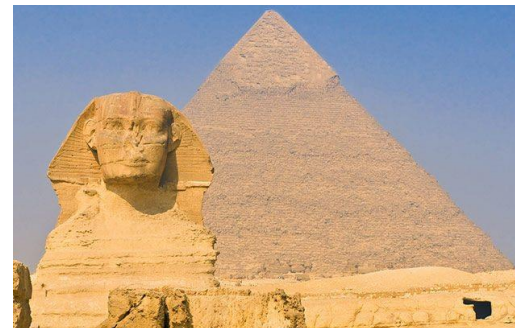

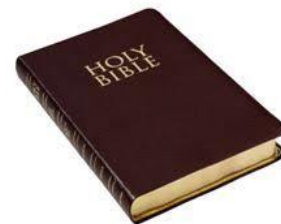

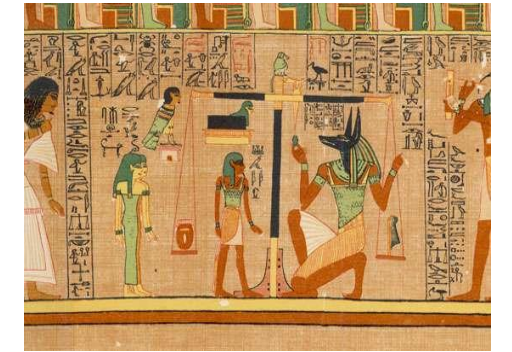
Music
