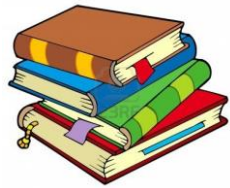


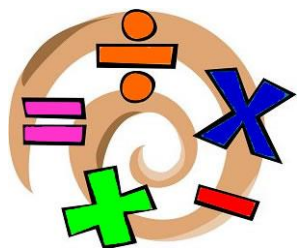
English

- Performance poetry – children will learn a simple poem to perform off-by-heart.
- Classic poetry – 'Beowulf' listening and comparing different versions
- Instructional text – How to be a Viking
- Myths and legends – Thor's Stolen Hammer
- Listening and comprehension skills – The Viking Sagas
- Grammar Focus – prepositions, the use of apostrophes for omission and possession. Identifying subordinate clauses



Maths

- Number – Place value: multiplying and dividing by 10, 100, 1000
- Decimal numbers and understanding tenths, hundredths.
- Measurement – area, perimeter and length
- Geometry - Angles, shape and symmetry, position and direction.
- Fractions – Find fractions of amounts
- Continue to learn all times tables facts to x12 and begin to learn related division facts
- Statistics – Interpret and present data
